The Water Resources Division has reviewed the water licence application for the above-mentioned undertaking. Due to the scale and nature of the project, there is no water licence requirement under the NWT Waters Act. Schedule VI of the Act exempts certain activities from Licence requirements, in this case the project is exempt because the deposit of waste will be in accordance with the General Sanitation Regulations of the Northwest Territories, the camp serves 50 or fewer people, and there is no direct or indirect deposit to surface waters. In addition, the water-related aspects of this project have been addressed by the provisions made in this application and the DIAND Land Use Permit.
