Subject: Approval for Jet-A Fuel at Lady Franklin Point North Warning System

Dear Mr. Kalen:

Thank-you for providing the details requested by the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) regarding the on-site disposal of Jet-A Fuel at the Lady Franklin Point North Warning System site. If the proposed activities are carried out as described in GC Forces' correspondence to the NWB (i.e. the incineration of approximately 540,000 litres of Jet-A Fuel will produce no ash or by-products that require further disposal), then the NWB is satisfied that the proposed activities meet all requirements of the Nunavut Waters and Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act and The Nunavut Waters Regulations, given that no significant impacts to any freshwater body will result from the incineration process. You may consider this correspondence as an official approval from the NWB that all its concerns for the proposed on-site incineration have been met.
