

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY
2021/2022 Annual Report for TC Licence No. 1BR-FTA1828
Cambridge Bay Land Treatment Units

Transport Canada operates two land treatment units located at the Cambridge Bay Airport on Victoria Island, Nunavut. The land treatment units were built to contain and treat contaminated soil from two different locations on the airport property. On behalf of Transport Canada, Stantec Consulting Ltd. completed supervision and environmental monitoring activities at the land treatment units between August 3rd to 12th, 2021. The environmental monitoring program was completed in accordance with the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) licence requirements. In addition to the environmental monitoring, soil mixing and water pumping took place, with the help of a local contractor, to increase evaporation of rainwater.

Transport Canada will continue annual monitoring and maintenance at the land treatment units in accordance with its NWB Licence and will provide operational updates, including plans for eventual site closure. Revised versions of the Abandonment and Restoration Plan and Apron Land Treatment Unit Risk Assessment are being submitted this year to the NWB.
