Transport Canada is planning to raise our land treatment unit berm walls at the Cambridge Bay Fire Training Area LTU (one of two LTU's covered by this license). This work is to ensure containment of sump water and soil into future years to extend the life of the structure. We are planning to complete this work in summer of 2023.

The Water License requires we get written permission from the NWB for any modifications to structures. The only planned change is to raise the berm walls with additional liner and aggregate. We are planning to submit the new design specifications, earthwork requirements, and a letter detailing the plans to the board. Would this be sufficient?

The LTU will function identically according to the existing license wording, and we are not requesting any changes to the license for this land treatment unit, therefore we will not be seeking an updated license.
