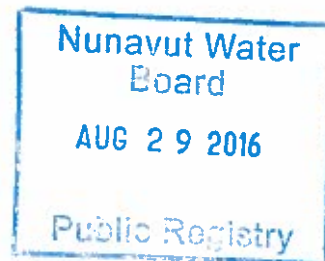

Pursuant to Section 14.1 of the *Nunavut Water Regulations (SOR/2013-69)* Defence Construction Canada on behalf of the Department of National Defence is providing the Nunavut Water Board with this package which fulfills the obligations to provide Annual Reports for each of the DEW Line sites located in Nunavut.

As you are aware the DEW Line sites are now in the Long Term Monitoring Phase of remediation. The current agreement between DND and NTI has the monitoring structured to include; Phase I (years 1-5 post construction), Phase II (years 7, 10, 15, and 25) and Phase III (yet to be determined). The reports generated by the monitoring contractors for the 2015 field season have been enclosed; please notice for those sites where no activity occurred in 2015, no monitoring report will be submitted to the NWB.
