The Nunavut Water Board acknowledges receipt on August 6, 2002 of your water licence application for the FOX-M Hall Beach Project. Your application included the following items:

- Cover letter dated August 2, 2002
- Water licence application form
- Sketches of project area
- Environmental screening report
- Background information
- Specifications for remediation of the beach refuel area
- Environmental protection plan

This project is exempt from payment of the application fee. You are, however, required to submit a project summary in both English and Inuktitut. Please forward at your earliest convenience.

This project is currently being screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board for their determination as to whether they require further review, or if it can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a <u>notice of your application is required</u>. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take "...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings]."

Accordingly, the enclosed notice in both English and Inuktitut will be posted for a period of 30 days, with the following establishments in Hall Beach and Igloolik:-Hamlet Office, QIA, HTO, Northern Store, and Co-op Store.

Upon request from the public, we ask you to make available, free of charge, copies of all documents pertaining to this application. Any person who is affected by this application or concerned with it, may submit a letter of concern, which must be submitted to the Board within the period of time shown on the public notice.
