## **RE**: NWB5HAL – Defence Construction Canada – FOX-M DEW Line Site, Hall Beach - Monitoring Plan

On behalf of Environment Canada (EC), I have reviewed the information submitted with the above-mentioned application. The following specialist advice has been provided pursuant to Environment Canada's mandated responsibilities for the enforcement of the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act*, Section 36(3) of the *Fisheries Act*, the *Migratory Birds Convention Act*, and the *Species at Risk Act*.

Defence Construction Canada, on behalf of the Department of National Defence, has submitted a monitoring plan as required by their current water license.

Section 3.1 of the Monitoring Plan discusses the monitoring of the East Beach Landfill. No information is given regarding proposed monitoring of water quality from the leachate collection system. Environment Canada recommends that the proponent ensure that any water collected in the leachate collection system is tested for the same suite of parameters as groundwater and if required, treated prior to disposal.

The Monitoring Plan does not address monitoring requirements at the landfarm facility, as indicated on drawing number H-H11/1-9101-113. Environment Canada recommends that the landfarm be added to the Monitoring Plan. Monitoring for hydrocarbons should be undertaken to ensure that groundwater quality is being protected. The berms surrounding the facility should also be monitored for stability.
