Water Licence Application, Igaluit Airport Drainage Ditch:

Some portions of the attached form have not been completed, and I'm not positive I have the correct set of forms. I have also been unable to find the required *Schedule II of Northwest Territories Waters Regulations for Description of Undertakings* and the *Supplementary Questionnaire*. Please advise where I can find these documents.

Our proposed project requires removing more than forty years of accumulated silt from an established drainage channel, and repairing and replacing culverts that have been damaged or covered through the course of those years. We will not be requiring any use of water; nor will we be discharging waste of any kind, or diverting the existing watercourse. The extent of watercourse alteration will be return of the ditch to its original design, in order to alleviate annual runoff flooding of airport movement surfaces.

Flooding of an aircraft Taxiway and an Apron have become annual events, resulting recently in damage to buildings and pavements. This project to rectify the situation is currently out to tender, with a planned closing date of September 19, 2005. CGS Projects has recently advised me that we will be unable to complete this work until Approval is received from the Water Board. I realize it is late to be consulting you, but still maintain some hope that we can complete this project prior to freeze-up this year.
