Thank you for the report. The application will go out once you have revised the application and have addressed all the concerns addressed in my February 17th, 2006 letter. I would once again like to reiterate that the law requires the application to be open to regulatory and public comment for a minimum of 30 days. Today is May 25th, 2006. I will be not in the office starting June 27th, 2006. Once the 30 day review period has closed a licence has to be drafted and brought to the Board for approval. This does not occur overnight and I would like to once again make you aware of the situation. If Regulatory or Public concerns are brought forward or the Board requires further clarity the application period before licence may be issued may take longer. This has been stated by me many times over the last 4 months. I will once again stress the need to provide sufficient detail. I would strongly suggest referencing my February 17th, 2006 letter to ensure all points have been significantly detailed in your revised application. If they have not been adequately addressed it will prolong the issuance of a licence.

The NWB has yet to receive a revised application from the GN (Iqaluit Airport Drainage). I would like once again make you aware of my upcoming schedule. As you are aware the Nunavut Waters Act calls for a 30 day review period. I will be on an annual holiday June 27th-July 15th 2006. I had made Transport Canada and the Government of Nunavut aware of this during our last teleconference. Thus to ensure a licence may possibly be brought to the Board prior to July 23rd, 2006 (it will take approximately a week to process, though this is simply an approximation and may require additional timing depending on comments from Interveners and Board concerns) we will need to send out the application by mid week this week (May 24th). I was expecting your revisions earlier and I wanted to give you fair warning on your potential situation.

As aforementioned I am not stapling time stamps to you when you may receive a licence. This is entirely dependent on the content of the application, the time of your submission, the nature of the Intervener comments, and Board concerns. I do strongly suggest submitting your adequately detailed redefined licence application as soon as possible so you may avoid an unfavorable situation. Please call me if needed.
