**RE: NPC File # 149117 [Groundwater Monitoring Well Installation and Sampling at Iqaluit Airport]**

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Groundwater monitoring activities: Transport Canada proposes the installation of three groundwater monitoring wells between the Former Firefighting Training Area (FFTA) and the airport property boundary to assess the presence/absence of contaminants associated with the FFTA.
2. Location: Qikiqtani Region [Iqaluit]
