Dear Mr. Quinn:

This is a reminder that your licences NWB5JEN0101, NWB5GLA0101, NWB5FRA0101 for water use and waste disposal associated with DEW-Line site investigations at CAM-1 (Jenny Lind Island), CAM-2 (Gladman Point), and PIN-3 (Lady Franklin Point Island) respectively expire on October 31, 2001.

As indicated in Part B, Item 1 of the permit, a summary report needs to be submitted to the Nunavut Water Board within thirty (30) of the expiration of the permits. These reports should include information about activities for the above permit, water quality data, abandonment and restoration of the site, list any unauthorized spills and the follow-up action taken, and any other relevant water use and waste disposal information. Please submit these reports no later than November 30, 2001.

Should you wish to continue with these site investigations, you will need to file an application for renewal of this permit.

An application form and supplementary questionnaire are attached to this letter. These can be filed electronically, by fax, or by regular mail. Please allow 3-4 months for the renewal process. For an application to be deemed complete the following are needed:

- completed application form
- completed supplementary questionnaire
- relevants maps/drawings (max. size 11" x 17")
- executive summary in both English and Inuktitut
- application fee of \$30 payable to the Receiver General of Canada
