The Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) is requesting an amendment to the Water License No. 1BR-KEI722 issued for the CAM-E DEW Line Environmental Site Remediation Project. The request is to amend the water usage quantity from 14 m³/day to 40 m³/day as per the explanation detailed below:

The volume of water usage approved in the existing water licence is fourteen (14) m³/day comprising of five (5) m³/day for camp use and nine (9) m³/day for construction and remediation activities. The project team is envisaging that there will be periods of time when the construction activities may require much more than the approved 9 m³/day. Moisture conditioning of the granular material may be required for the construction of the Non-Hazardous Waste Landfill, as well as the saturated berms of the Tier II Landfill. The current borrow area is sufficiently saturated such that only minimal moisture conditioning is required; however; should this area dry out or should the other borrow sources have much lower moisture content, then additional water will be required. Based on the latter scenario, the project team has estimated that the water volume of 35 m³/day (instead of the 9 m³/day approved for the existing licence) will be required for construction activities at the site. The camp use remains unchanged at 5 m³/day. Hence the total water usage for the site has therefore changed from 14 m³/day to 40 m³/day. Water for construction purposes has been, and will continue to be, sourced from seasonal wet areas local to the borrow sources and landfill sites. These water sources were visually inspected, and based on the depth and observations they are believed to not be fish bearing. The camp water will be sourced from the Freshwater Lake.

Besides the Water Licence, INAC holds a Land Use Permit (LUP) and Quarrying permits (QPs) with the INAC Land Administration. Remediation is taking place only on Crown Land. Therefore, no IOL or other permit/exemption certificate is required for this project.
