The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Amend water licensing for CAM-E Keith Bay Long Term Post Closure Monitoring.
2. There are no modifications to the project. However, the number of staff on site have been reduced, estimated number of days on site have been reduced, equipment and fuel are no longer needed, and only other waste type remains for the site.
3. Associated NPC File No: 148627, 148190; Related NIRB File No. 16DN001.
4. Location: Kitikmeot Region (Keith Bay; 75 kilometres east from Kugaaruk).
