Dear Ms. Lamontagne:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) has completed a technical review of the 2017 Annual Report (the Report) for Type "B" Water Licence 1BR-KEI1722 (the Licence). The Report was received on August 31, 2018 from Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC or the Licensee), submitted as a requirement under Part B of the Licence.

NWB noted the following deficiencies in the course of the Report review:

1) The allowable domestic water use of five (5) cubic metres per day was exceeded. The Report indicates 8.5 m³/day as the actual rate of water use. In addition, the Report indicates that the permitted rate of water use is 14 m³/day, which was prescribed by the original Licence but amended on November 29, 2017. NWB would like to remind the Licensee not to exceed the maximum permitted rate of water use. If the Licensee forecasts an increase in water requirement over the allowable limit, the Licensee ought to apply for a Licence amendment. 2) The results of the monitoring program prescribed in Licence Part K are not provided in the 2017 annual report.
