Good afternoon,

I am following up regarding amendments to the water license for CAM-E (1BR-KEI1722). Please advise the status of the amendment requests submitted on June 16, 2017.

In addition, a discrepancy was noted in the current version of the license, pertaining to the discharge criteria for contact water, barrel water and demolition rinsate. In "Part D – Conditi to Waste Disposal", item 11, discharge of site contact water was to be sampled for the following parameters:

Parameter	Maximum Allowable Concentration
pН	6.0 to 9.0 (pH units)
TSS	50
Oil and Grease	15 mg/L and no visible sheen
Total Lead	0.001 mg/L
Benzene	0.370 mg/L
Toluene	0.002 mg/L
Ethylbenzene	0.090 mg/L
Xylenes	0.18 mg/L
