Subject: CAM-E, Keith Bay Long Term Monitoring Plan Approval

Dear Charlotte Lamontagne, Dele Morakinyo:

On July 3, 2019, the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) acknowledged the receipt of *CAM-E, Keith Bay Long Term Monitoring Plan* (Plan) from Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs (CIRNA or Licensee) as per the requirement of Part K, Item 9 of Water Licence No. 1BR-KEI1722 (Licence). The Plan was dated September 12, 2018.

The NWB distributed the Plan for public review with a deadline for submissions set for August 2, 2019. No comments were received.

By copy of this letter, the Board approves the *CAM-E*, *Keith Bay Long Term Monitoring Plan* dated September 12, 2018. However, the Board finds that additional information is required and advises the Licensee that an updated Plan is to be submitted on or before **October 10, 2019**. The updated Plan is to address the following:

- Inclusion of an acceptance letter from an analytical laboratory accredited by the Canadian Association for Laboratory Accreditation Inc. (CALA);
- Adding turbidity testing into the list of groundwater monitoring parameters as per the *Abandoned Military Site Remediation Protocol*; and
- Ensuring that all engineering drawings are stamped and signed by an Engineer.
