Dear Ms. Beaulieu,

Please find enclosed a Water Licence Application from Aboriginal Affairs and Northern Development Canada (AANDC) for the Fox-D Site Remediation Project.

FOX-D (Kivitoo) was an Intermediate Distant Early Warning (DEW) Line Site constructed in 1957 and operated until October 1963. The site is located on the Davis Strait. The site is located 50 km to the west of the nearest community, Qikiqtarjuaq, Nunavut, at approximately 67° 57' 01" N latitude and 64° 55' 04" W longitude. The site is accessible by fixed wing aircraft, helicopter, and sealift. In addition to a Water Licence, AANDC is applying for a Land Use Permit from AANDC, an Access to Inuit Owned Land Permit from the Qikiqtani Inuit Association, as well as applying to the Nunavut Impact Review Board for associated approvals.
