Apologies to the delay in responding to you.

You are correct, based on the location of the activities in FOX-D (Kivitoo, Nunavut) you are proposing, it is located outside the boundaries of an approved land use plan therefore no requirement a conformity determination review with an approved plan.

But, NuPPAA regulations require all proposed projects including amendments to existing authorized projects and new project proposals located inside the designated area [Nunavut Settlement Area] be submitted to the NPC for review. Michael, those projects that are located outside the boundaries of an approved plan are now required to be reviewed by the NPC to determine whether a NIRB screening is required. Your project as described below will require a NPC review if it is not an extension to an existing authorized project.

I'm pulling together permitting/licensing for the remediation of contaminants of FOX-D (Kivitoo, Nunavut), which was an Intermediate Distant Early Warning (DEW) Line Site constructed in 1957 and operated until October 1963. The site is located on the Davis Straight, 50km to the west of the nearest community Qikiqtarjuaq, at approximately 67° 57' 01" N latitude and 64° 55' 04" W longitude.

I'm of the understanding that this area is in the South Baffin planning area and due to the fact that it does not have a finalized Land Use Plan, it's not subject to a conformity review.
