Dear Ms. Kydd:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB) has completed a technical review of the 2017 Annual Report received on March 29, 2018. The Annual Report was submitted with an updated Spill Contingency Plan, which is the subject of a separate letter.

On April 20, 2018, the NWB acknowledged receipt of the Annual Report and provided it/them to the Qikiqtani distribution list for information. No comments have been received to date.

The technical review of the Annual Report found that additional information is necessary to meet the following requirements of the Licence:

- Part B, Item 1 lists the information to be included in the Annual Report including:
  - b. Characterization of soils treated at the Landfarm Facility or the Biological / Aeration Treatment Unit;

The Annual Report did not provide any information about the operation of the Landfarm (soil treatment facility) or the quantity and characteristics of the materials placed there for treatment.

Please provide this information in the 2018 Annual Report and all future reports. Please review all sections of your Licence, especially Part B, Item 1 to ensure all reporting requirements are addressed. If for some reason data or information is not available, include a discussion indicating:

What information is missing;

- Why it was not provided; and
- Steps being made to provide it in the future.

The NWB notes that the Licensee has not provided all the submissions previously required by the Licence:

## • Part F, Item 1:

The Licensee shall submit to the Board for approval in writing, at least forty-five (45) days prior to commencing operation of the **Sewage Disposal Facility and the Landfarm Facility**, an **operations and maintenance manual** that includes procedures for operating both facilities as well monitoring requirements and other relevant information.

To date, the NWB has no record of receiving this information. Based on the 2017 Annual Report sewage disposal has occurred at site and the Landfarm Facility has been constructed.

## • Part J, Item 2:

Licensee shall submit to the Board, for review and acceptance in writing, within thirty (30) days from the date of issuance of Amendment No. 1, an **addendum to the** [Remedial Action Plan] referred to in Part J, Item 1 to reflect the change requested and granted under this Amendment No.1.

To date, the NWB has no record of receiving this information, which was due on August 6, 2017.
