RE: NWB Technical Review of 2017 Spill Contingency Plan for the FOX-D, Kivitoo Remediation Project; Water Licence No. 1BR-KIV1621

Dear Ms. Kydd:

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) has completed a technical review of the 2017 Spill Contingency Plan (SCP) received on March 29, 2018. The SCP was submitted with the 2017 Annual Report, which is the subject of a separate letter.

On April 20, 2018, the NWB acknowledged receipt of the SCP and provided it to the Qikiqtani distribution list for information. No comments have been received to date.

The technical review of the SCP found that additional information is necessary for this SPC to meet the following requirements of the Licence:

- Part I, Item 2 states:

The Licensee is required to submit to the Board for review and acceptance, within thirty (30) following issuance of Amendment No.1, the final version of the plan approved under Part I, Item 1 to address minor deficiencies including the contractor contact information.

The SCP provides very little contact information and does not include:

- The name, job title, and 24 hour telephone number for the persons responsible for activating the contingency plan; and

- Emergency contacts such as:
CIRNAC Water Resource Inspector,
NWT/NU Spill Line
GN, Environmental Protection
Nunavut Water Board
CIRNAC Project Manager
Qikiqtani Inuit Association
DFO
Environment and Climate Change Canada.

The NWB notes that this information, except for the contractor contact information, was in the original SCP for 1BR-KIV1621.

Please submit to the Board for review by March 31, 2019, an update to the SCP. The update can be submitted in the form of an addendum or appendix, and must include emergency contact information as discussed in this letter.
