Ms. Beaulieu: On March 3, 2010, we had provided your office with a drawing for the water discharge splash pad to be constructed this year at the Kugaaruk soil treatment landfarm. Since the date of that submission, our client, the Nunavut Department of Community and Government Services, has requested a revision to the original design of the splash pad. The revision involves replacing the proposed concrete structure with a design that employs geotextile and riprap. In our opinion the design change will not affect the overall performance of the splash pad and will not alter the environmental impacts discussed in the original Licence application or the renewal application package. The use of riprap will allow more use of local materials and will facilitate the eventual decommissioning of this structure.

A copy of the drawing showing the revised splash design is attached. It would be appreciated if this drawing could be added to the water licence renewal application to replace the original drawing.
