## Re: 2003 Annual Report - NWB5LON0308

On behalf of Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC), I would like to thank the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) for the opportunity to provide comment on the 2003 Annual Report for the Longstaff Bluff DEW line clean-up. The 2003 Annual Report was issued by UMA Engineering Ltd. (UMA) on behalf of the Defence Construction Canada (the Licensee), in accordance with Part B, Item 1 of Water Licence NWB5LON0308 (the Current Licence).

The 2003 Annual Report adequately addressed a number of the requirements of Part B, Item 1 of the Current Licence. INAC would draw the Licencee's and UMA's attention, however, to the following annual reporting requirements (at minimum) that were absent from the 2003 Annual Report:

- Part B, 1.I The monthly and annual quantities (in cubic metres) of fresh water obtained from all sources.
- Part B, 1.ii The monthly and annual quantities (in cubic metres) or material deposited in solid waste facilities.
- Part B, 1.x A public consultation/participation report describing consultation with local organizations and the residents of nearby communities
- Part B, 1.xii An executive summary in English and Inuktitut of all plans, reports, or studies conducted under this Licence

INAC therefore recommends that the Licensee and/or UMA review Part B, Section 1 of the Current Licence, and provide any outstanding information to the NWB at the earliest available opportunity.
