The 2008 Annual Report satisfactorily addressed the applicable requirements of Part B, Item 1 of the current water licence #1BR-LON0813. Most of the conditions under the water licence were not applicable this year as no work occurred at the site in 2008. DCD did submit electronic copies of an updated Spill Contingency Plan, a Monitoring Plan, a Post Closure Monitoring Plan, QA/QC Plans, and an Operation and Maintenance Plan, as per requirements of the water use license for FOX-2. It is anticipated that construction work will begin in the 2009 construction season. As such, it is expected that the licensee will provide all applicable information in their Annual Report.
