The Nunavut Water Board has reviewed the “Proposed Monitoring Plan – License No. NWB5LON0308” documents submitted to the Board on August 18, 2003 in accordance with Part J, Item 1 of your water license. The NWB herein conditionally approves the Plan, with the requirement that the Licensee provide to the Board, as an addendum to the approved Plan the following information, when said information becomes available upon completion of the remediation program:

- i. GPS coordinates of all surface and subsurface sampling points; and
- ii. Specific components of the visual, soil/water and thermal monitoring program;
- iii. Sampling frequency; and
- iv. Physical and chemical parameters for analyses.
