Subject: Submission of the 2009 Annual Report for the Cape Christian Site Remediation Project under Water Licence No. 1BR-LOR0813

Dear Mr. Morakinyo:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") has completed a technical review of the 2009 Annual Report for the above-referenced project, received March 9, 2010 and submitted by Indian and Northern Affairs Canada – Contaminated Sites Program. The Annual Report did not address several requirements of Part B, Item 1 of Licence 1BR-LOR0813 including:

1. Sampling results and a tabular summary of discharges from facilities including the Sewage Disposal Facility and Non-Hazardous Waste Landfill. If discharges occurred from these facilities in 2009, said information shall be provided to the Board by March 31, 2010.
2. Executive summary in English and Inuktitut of all plans, reports, or studies were not included in the report.

The Annual Report identified that an 80 litre spill contaminated approximately 10 cubic metres of soils. Please be aware that discharge concentrations listed under Part D, Item 12 apply to all contact water with the stored contaminated soil.

The Annual Report also stated that a single-cell lagoon will be decanted in 2010; NWB request that information on the receiving water bodies be provided in the 2010 Annual Report and encourages adherence to Part D, Item 9 of the terms and conditions of the Licence.
