**RE: Submission of Long-Term Monitoring Plan, Indian and Northern Affairs ( Canada (INAC), Contaminated Sites; Cape Christian LORON Site, Licence No. 1BR-LOR0813**

Dear Mr. Morakinyo:

The Nunavut Water Board (“NWB” “Board”) received on January 12, 2011, from Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC), the Plan entitled “CAPE CHRISTIAN LONG TERM MONITORING PLAN,” dated February 10, 2009. On January 21, 2011, the NWB acknowledged receipt and distributed the document to interested parties and persons for a thirty-day review and comment period, ending February 21, 2010. On or before the deadline for submissions, comments<sup>1</sup> were received from two intervening parties: Environment Canada (EC) and Indian and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC). The intervening parties made specific recommendations with respect to improving the general functionality of the Plan.

An internal review of the plan has determined that it is acceptable and generally consistent with the requirements under Licence 1BR-LOR0813. The Board has therefore approved the Plan under *Motion No. 2010-28-L02*. However, to address issues raised by the intervening parties, the Licensee is required to submit to the Board for review, within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter, an addendum to the Plan. The addendum should address the following items:

- a. Include Mercury on the list of parameters outlined in section 2.1.1 of the Plan for which soil samples will be analyzed, as required in Table No. 1 under Licence 1BR-LOR0813;
- b. Remove and replace, accordingly, the reference being made to FOX-C on page 7 of the plan;
- c. Include in section 2.3 of the Plan the requirement to conduct a preliminary review of Phase 1 monitoring data at the end of the third year of monitoring; and
- d. Provide revised versions of the figures depicted in Appendix A, B, C and D of the Plan. The ones provided are not legible enough.
