The Nunavut Water Board received an application for a new permit on May 1, 2002 from UMA Engineering Ltd. on behalf of Defence Construction Canada for water use and waste disposal associated with a camp and site investigation for future DEW-line clean-up activities.

In accordance with Articles 12 and 13 of the *Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada*, this project shall be screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board to determine whether it has significant impact potential, and whether it requires review, before the application can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.
