LICENCE AMENDMENT No. 1

Pursuant to its authority under Article 13 of the *Agreement between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada* and the *Nunavut Waters* and the *Nunavut Surface Rights Tribunal Act*, the Nunavut Water Board hereby grants the following Licence amendment.

The Licence issued July 31, 2007 with an expiry date of December 31, 2012 shall be amended to include the following terms and conditions, with respect to use of water during DEW line site remediation, to allow Defence Construction Canada to draw water for domestic and industrial uses from a different lake than on the original Licence at the CAM-5 (Mackar Inlet) DEW line site in the Qikiqtani Region at latitude 68°17'N and longitude 85°07'W.

All instances (decision Pg. i, Introduction and Procedural history Pg. 1 and Scope Pg.5) of:

“...located approximately 150 km *west* of the community of Kugaaruk...”

shall be changed to:

“...located approximately 150 km *east* of the community of Kugaaruk...”

III. General Conditions, (Page 2), shall be changed in the following area:

B. Water Use

“The CAM-5 DEW Line site currently receives water from an on-site Water Supply Lake.”

shall be changed to:

“The CAM-5 DEW Line site previously received water from on-site Water Supply Lake. This source was changed due to poor water quality to another on-site lake, identified on drawings submitted as part of the amendment application.”

2. Definitions, (Page 7), shall be amended in the following area:

““**Water Supply Facilities**’ comprises the Water Supply Lake area and associated infrastructure designed to collect and supply water, as described in the application filed by the Applicant on September 28, 2005 and illustrated in Drawing # H-M27/I-9101/101;”

shall be changed to:

“‘**Water Supply Facilities**’ compromises the ‘Water Source’ and associated infrastructure designed to collect and supply water, as indicated on drawing number H-27/1-9101-101 included as part of the amendment application and in the application filed by the Applicant on September 28, 2005;”

PART C: CONDITIONS APPLYING TO WATER USE

Amend Item 1

The Licensee shall obtain water for domestic and industrial use from the 'Water Source' (MAC-1) as indicated on drawing number H-M27/1-9101-101 included as part of the amendment application for the CAM-5 (Mackar Inlet) DEW Line Site, up to a maximum of fifty five (55) cubic meters per day.

All remaining terms and conditions of the Licence 1BR-MAC0712 Type ‘B’ dated July 31, 2007 still apply.
