In response to your e-mail on June 22, 2017, Transport Canada (TC) has reviewed the letter submitted by Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) dated June 7, 2017 and TC provides the following responses to Recommendations 1 through 4:

TC Response to Recommendation 1:

Transport Canada confirms that dust suppression measures will be implemented on an asrequired basis, depending on site conditions. Only water would be used for dust suppression and it would be trucked to the site from municipal sources in Iqaluit, not taken from any local water sources on-site.

TC Response to Recommendation 2:

Transport Canada confirms that appropriate best practices for erosion control during construction, operation, and decommissioning of the temporary site road will be implemented. It is not anticipated the road will cross any drainage features on-site. Transport Canada will ensure implementation of appropriate contingency measures, as necessary, should any concerns be identified with site drainage and erosion along the road feature.

TC Response to Recommendation 3:

Transport Canada confirms that all appropriate approvals will be obtained from any receiving facilities for waste associated with this project.



TC Response to Recommendation 4:

Transport Canada confirms that appropriate waste management measures will be implemented, including secondary containment when storing contaminated soils and sediments prior to disposal.
