Good afternoon, Mike:

As a follow-up to our conversation today, please let me restate that the Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) received from Transport Canada (TC or Proponent) separate applications for consideration in support of two proposed projects: the Iqaluit Metal Dump Remediation Project (1BR-MDR---) and the Resolute Bay Landfills Remediation Project (1BR-RBL). The Board distributed the applications for public comments on June 24, 2011 and July 23, 2011, respectively.

Subsequent to the deadline for comments, Transport Canada requested in writing that the Board delay issuance of the licenses for the projects until TC is able to secure the required funding to undertake the undertakings. Since no definite timeframe was provided for securing funding for the projects, the Board has kept the status of both file active. However, the Board is at a juncture where it requires relevant justification(s) for continuing to keep these files active given the time that has elapsed and the continued funding-related uncertainties and challenges confronting the files. The Board therefore requests that Transport Canada provide written confirmation that would support the Board's closing of the files or information on the definite timeframe(s), in the short-term (months), by which TC intends carry out the undertakings.

With respect to file 1BR-RLF---, the Resolute Bay Landfarm Remediation Project, the Board requests that TC provide written confirmation on whether the Board should issue the Licence for the file or treat the file in a manner that is consistent with the files mentioned above.
