Subject: Licence No. 1BR-MDR1721; Submission under Part K, Item 1, of a Performance & Long Term Monitoring Plan (LTM), Former Metal Dump and Community Landfill

Dear Jackie Barker,

The Nunavut Water Board (NWB or Board) received from Transport Canada (TC) on August 14, 2017, the Performance & Long Term Monitoring Plan (LTM), Former Metal Dump and Community Landfill, dated August 3, 2017, as a requirement of Part K, Item 1 of the NWB Licence No. 1BR-MDR1721.

The Plan was distributed for a public review and comments with a deadline for submission set at September 1, 2017. The Board received communication from Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) on August 31, 2017, and Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) on September 1, 2017. Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) wrote to confirm that the submitted Plan was reviewed, found to be adequate, and that they had no further concerns with the Plan. Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) submitted three (3) main recommendations all of which were addressed by Transport Canada (the Licensee) in their September 12, 2017 follow-up submission.

By copy of this letter the Board acknowledges that the Plan addresses the requirements of Part K, Item 1 of Licence 1BR-MDR1721, and has approved the Plan through the Board Motion No. **2017-B1-031**, dated September 21, 2017. The Licensee is also advised that the Board's "approval" of this document is a verification that the proposed activities are consistent with the existing terms and conditions of the Licence and more specifically with the Part K, Item 1, and may proceed in accordance with the Plan.
