Hi Ida / Nunavut Water Board (NWB),

The Indigenous and Northern Affairs Canada (INAC) Water group, one of the reviewers of the Surface Water Monitoring Plan (SWMP), has pointed our attention to certain details that require to be corrected in the SWMP that was submitted to your office regarding the Nottingham Island Remediation Project. The group also informed us that they secured, from Nunavut Water Board (NWB), an extension of the review period to April 18, 2016.

We have contacted our consultant (Stantec) that authored the SWMP and he has advised us that he will need up to the end of the month of April to fix the mistakes in the plan. We are, therefore using this medium to request that the review period for this document be extended to April 29, 2016 to allow us time to fix the errors.
