When the new water licence was delivered to NESI in January of 2013 a condition of the licence was to have a detailed cost estimate of reclamation by a 3rd party. We approached Nunavut Excavating a construction company located beside the landfarm who agreed to supply the cost estimate. Delays occurred with management changes and with new staff not familiar with the process of aerating the soil. This required NESI to show and explain the process required to do this job to a couple of people from Nunavut Excavation and to show them details of time and machine hours. We just received a written estimate from them on Tuesday of this week.

The manager at Nunavut Excavating Cory Mullet estimated equipment time based on using their excavator, loader and trucks. The exception is using the screening plants, stackers and fertilizer from NESI. This accounts for the difference in price from NESI estimate which show NESI equipment being used and third party supplying only labour to operate the machines as well as fuel and some maintenance.

I met with Mr. Mullet on a few occasions to explain the reason for aeration and turning of soil as well as what to expect for timeline being spread out over a few years. For this reason he was not willing to commit to an exact price due to the unknown. He chose to give a yearly price for turning of soil and a final price to remove all liners and level out the land contained within the fenced perimeter.

I trust this will meet with your approval.

К	Nunatta was contacted by Richard Moore to pump out and remove old fuel tanks located on uphill side of building. Tanks had been pumped out 5-7 years ago when a leak was reported. Fuel collected from spill was put into plastic tank and left on site. (quanity unknown) soil was added to soak up fuel in tank but tank was never removed from site. Sunlight degraded tank and contents leache into ground. At some point tanks were refilled and building lived in. (time and length of stay unknow) When tanks were removed we noted strong smell coming from ground under old tanks. Ice prevented us from excavting and decision was made to wait for ground to thaw. Yesterday Mr Moore joined us to do some test holes to determine the extent of the spill area. Soil is very strong suggesting a lot of fuel into the ground. Outside the tank area the spill is 6 meters by 3 meters and at least 1 meter depth or until we hit permafrost. Area under the building (downhill) unknown until we begin to excavate.							n site.
