## Re: Notice of Part 4 Screening for Nunatta Environmental Services Inc.'s "Land Farm" project proposal

Dear James Wilson:

On June 7, 2011 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Nunatta Environmental Services Inc.'s (Nunatta or the Company) "Land Farm" project proposal from your office. On March 27, 2012 the NIRB received correspondence from the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) indicating that the project is located outside an approved planning boundary and that no conformity determination would be required for the above mentioned project. A request to screen the project proposal was received from the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) on April 5, 2012 and the NIRB assigned this project proposal file number 12UN019.

The project is located in the Municipality of Iqaluit. The Company began providing environmental services in 1999, and has conducted ongoing land farming services to remediate hydrocarbon contaminated soils from fuel/heating oil spills as well as partaking in larger remediation projects for DEW (Distant Early Warning) line sites, mining companies, and government departments. The company is required to renew its water licence 1BR-NUN0511 to continue ongoing operations for 10 years.

## The project activities include:

- Remediation of hydrocarbon contaminated water, soil and aggregate;
- Approximately 3 to 20 cubic metres per year of water to be treated by clay/carbon filter followed by evaporation discharge; and
- Approximately 200-1300 cubic metres per year of soil to be treated using aeration and fertilizer for eventual use in gardens, as dump cover, and on roads.

The NIRB is copying parties and municipalities potentially affected by Nunatta's project proposal with this letter, and we invite interested parties to comment directly to the NIRB by May 2, 2012.

The NIRB would like parties to provide comments regarding:

- Whether the project proposal is likely to arouse significant public concern; and if so, why;
- Whether the project proposal is likely to cause significant adverse eco-systemic and socio-economic effects; and if so, why;
- Whether the project is of a type where the potential adverse effects are highly predictable and mitigable with known technology, (please provide any recommended mitigation measures); and
- Any matter of importance to the Party related to the project proposal.
