SECTION 1

The Water Licence No. 1BR-NUN1828 is issued to allow for the continued deposition of waste (effluent from the facility and runoff) in support of the Nunatta Environmental Services Inc. landfarm facility designed to treat hydrocarbon impacted soil. The facility is located at the North 40 Industrial Park, adjacent to the Transport Canada legacy metal dump site, within the City of Iqaluit, Nunavut.

Non-Compliance with Act or Licence

The Landfarm facility, which consists of four (4) separate cells, receives and biologically treats soil that generally originates from the clean-up of residential areas affected by fuel oil associated with home heating equipment and/or other sources. The soil treated at the Landfarm facility is generally contaminated with varying concentration of diesel, gasoline and various industrial oils. Each cell of the Landfarm is lined with a geo-synthetic, high density, polyethylene material (geosynthetic liner) to prevent or minimize contaminants from entering the surrounding soil and ground water.

Inspection

On Wednesday June 2nd, 2021 I Jonathan Mesher, Crown Indigenous Affairs and Northern Relations Canada Inspector, did perform an inspection of the Water Licence 1BR-NUN1828 located in Iqaluit, Nunavut, the below observations were noted.

SECTION 2

- 1. The licensee has not deposited any waste under their licence this year and has not deposited waste since 2016.
- 2. The licensee has transferred the soil from the Cell 2 to the Qikiqtaaluk Environmental Inc., this soil was being temporally stored are the Nunatta landfarm. This cell is scheduled for a liner replacement, in 2020 Mr. Wilson stated that the liner will be replaced once the soil is transferred to another facility. See photo 1 below for a picture of Cell 2.
- 3. There was a small rip on the crest of the liner in cell 4.
- 4. No other concerns were noted during this inspection.
