Dear Ms. Schulz:

On March 23, 2001, I sent a letter to you indicating receipt of your water licence application, along with a distribution list to whom the application package should be distributed to.

It has been determined by the Nunavut Impact Review Board that this application can be processed without a review, and is now ready for processing by the Nunavut Water Board.

I have been asked by the Board to inform you that a <u>notice of your application is required</u>. This notice of requirement is based on Article 13.3.14 of the Nunavut Land Claims Agreement (NLCA), which states that the Board should take "...all steps necessary by way of notice...to provide and promote public awareness [of hearings]."

Accordingly, please have the enclosed notice in both English and Inuktitut published in a two-column width format in the **News North** as per enclosed "Instructions for Publication of Notice in Newspaper." The Applicant is responsible for payment of the publication.

In addition to the packages being sent to the distribution list, we ask you to make available, free of charge, copies of all documents pertaining to this application when they are requested by the public. Any person who is affected by this application or concerned with it, may submit a letter of concern, which must be submitted to the Board within the period of time shown on the public notice.

Please note that the confirmation of notice posting, must be submitted to our office before your application process will be completed.
