Re: Renewal Application Acknowledgement for CAM-4 Pelly Bay DEW Line Site

Dear Mr. Craig:

The Nunavut Water Board ("NWB") acknowledges receipt on April 27, 2010 of your new water license application for the CAM-4 Pelly Bay DEW Line Site, file number 1BR-PEL0510.

We undertook a preliminary review of your application and conclude that, in accordance with approved legislation under the *Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada* ("NLCA"), it does not contain sufficient information for the NWB to commence processing the file at this time. Specifically, we are asking you to provide the following:

- An updated Spill Contingency Plan that reflects the current status of the site (previous plan on file is from 2002);
- The 2009 Annual Report including the results of the 2009 Monitoring Program;
- Although the current Licence does not appear to require Stamped and Signed as-builts for the Tier II soil disposal facility and the Non-Hazardous Waste Landfills, this information should be submitted to the NWB prior to going out for a 30 day public comment period;
- The Tier II Soil Disposal Facility has some leeching and staining present, the applicant should address whether this is expected and is due to upper layer flow or whether Tier II contaminants are leaching;
- Provide criteria used to determine whether a constructed facility has failed and therefore requires immediate repair; and

- Will the applicant be implementing the various recommendations made in the March 4, 2009 Summary of Recommendations Letter?

We will resume the processing of your application once we receive the requested information.
