Hi Rita.

Because of the remoteness of the DEW Line sites and the difficulty in getting the samples to the lab in time and intact, many of the analyses are performed on-site. QA/QC measures are followed the same as if the samples were being analyzed in a southern laboratory.

In the water use license NWB5PEL0104 (and likely for future licenses), Section B of the SNP states that, "All analyses shall be performed in a laboratory approved by the Board." Does this imply we are not to do on-site analyses?

Could you please clarify this?
