The licence requires that quantities of raw water intake from the freshwater supply lake be reported; however, all water and sewer services for the construction camp during the clean up are being provided by the Hamlet of Kugaruuk (formerly Pelly Bay). Correspondence from the Nunavut Water Board (NWB) dated October 1, 2001, stated that if community services are used, these quantities do not need to be monitored. Therefore, no quantities of water and sewer usage are being recorded.

The licence also requires that samples of runoff from the existing landfills and the Tier II Disposal Facility being constructed be collected. There has been no runoff from the existing landfills or the Tier II Disposal Facility during this construction season; therefore, no samples have been collected.
