On April 9, 2001, the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) confirmed that this application does not fall within the boundary of the North Baffin Regional Land Use Plan, and as such, the project is not subject to conformity review by NPC, prior to being processed by your office.

In accordance with Articles 12 and 13 of the Agreement Between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in Right of Canada, this project shall be screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board to determine whether it has significant impact potential, and whether it requires review, before the application can be processed by the Nunavut Water Board.
