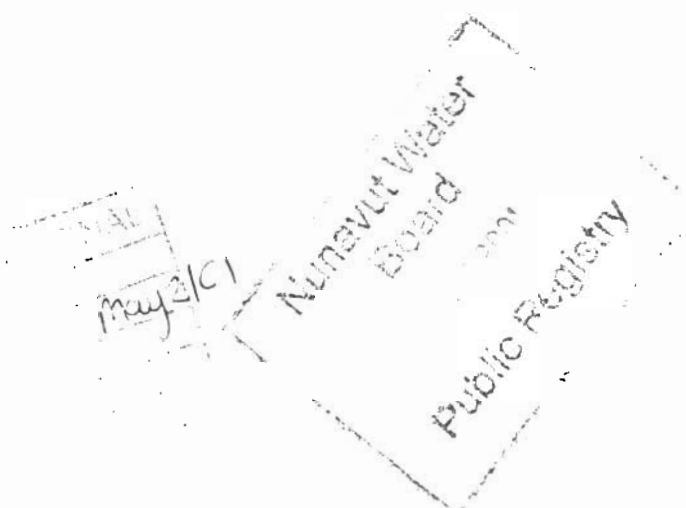

Environmental Canada's contribution to your request for specialist advice is based primarily on the mandated responsibilities for the enforcement of Section 36 of the *Fisheries Act*, the *Migratory Birds Convention Act* (MBCA), and the *Canadian Environmental Protection Act* (CEPA). On the basis of the information provided, Environmental Canada has concluded that the proposal does not have the potential to affect fish, nor does it give cause for any concerns under the MBCA or CEPA and its regulations; therefore, EPB has no concerns with this project.
