

AECOM Canada Ltd. is submitting the following notification request regarding the above noted water use license for the FOX-5, Qikiqtarjuaq DEW Line site. The notification is being submitted on behalf of Defence Construction Canada and the Department of National Defence.

A modification to this water use license was received in 2009 to include additional demolition, landfill expansion, debris removal and additional landfill excavation. We are now adding the demolition of another building (heated vehicle storage building at the airstrip area) to the same work package. The dismantled building components will be placed in the new cell of the Middle Site Non-Hazardous Waste Landfill, which was part of the previous modification approval. All of the hazardous material from the building was removed during the previous clean-up program, so there will not be any hazardous material to dispose of. It is anticipated that the work will be completed either this summer or summer 2012.
