Note that in accordance with Section 1.5 of the Resolution Island Monitoring Program (2003), a review of the monitoring requirement for the site will be conducted following the field work scheduled to be undertaken this year.

Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) screening exemption was provided directly from NIRB to the NWB on Friday July 18, 2010. Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) confirmation that conformity review was not required for an INAC Land Use Permit extension at Resolution Island was obtained on December 22, 2008 (Appendix G). It is our understanding that no change to the status of Resolution Island with respect to territorial land use plans has been made since December 2008. INAC Contaminated Sites has informed NPC that an amendment to the water license at Resolution Island has been submitted.
