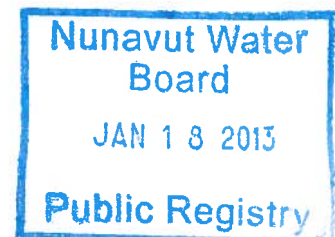
Transport Canada submitted an application to the Nunavut Water Board for the Resolute Bay Landfill remediation project in 2011. Prior to the Nunavut Water Board issuing the water license, Transport Canada requested that the project be delayed due to a lack of funds in order to complete the project.

Transport Canada is pleased to notify the Nunavut Water Board that funding has been committed for the project and requests the application be reinstated. The anticipated start date for the project is July 2013. The construction phase will require three years to complete and 2 additional years for monitoring and follow up. Therefore, the water license will be required for a period of 5 years ending in September 2017.
