The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Clean-up and remediation of former Pole Vault Line military installation on Resolution Island.
2. Modifications to the original/amended project proposal: expansion of the temporary camp to accommodate 30 people, incineration and/or off-site transport and disposal of waste fuels in barrels and fuel storage tanks; Excavation and off-site disposal of contaminated soil; Roads and airstrip will be repaired as necessary...

4. Location: Qikiqtani Region; former Pole Vault Line military installation on Resolution Island, near Cape Warwick, Brewer bay.
