PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed "Resolution Island Long Term Monitoring" project is located within the Qikiqtani (south Baffin) region, approximately 310 kilometres (km) southeast from Iqaluit. The Proponent intends to conduct remediation activities of the former Pole Vault Line military installation on Resolution Island to address deficiencies identified through long term monitoring activities at Resolution Island. The program is proposed to take place from summer 2018 to summer 2019. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Mobilization and demobilization of equipment, materials/wastes
- Establishment a temporary camp to accommodate a maximum of 30 personnel
- Excavation of contaminated soil and off-site disposal of contaminated soil
- Decommissioning of existing fuel storage systems;
