


Photograph VI-9: Gabion Walls Were Constructed to Form the Channel Through Which Water From the S1/S4 Beach Area Then Was Forced to Flow




Photograph VI-10: After the Geocomposite Clay Liner was Placed in Position, It was Wetted to Form a Sealed Channel
