Crown-Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs Canada (CIRNAC) Contaminated Sites Program currently has 11 water licences to conduct long term monitoring at 11 post-remediation sites in Nunavut. Please find attached annual reports for the sites that were not visited in 2025:
