- On Page 12, the first paragraph "Currently on site there are not spill kits, however, five should be brought to the site. These will be stored at the upper site at the helipad tank, the camp tanks, and the monitoring camp barrel caches; while the other two will be stored at the beach tanks.
 Workers will be informed of their locations and how to properly use the spill kits prior to commencing the work on site" is no longer correct. The spill kits are now on site at the specified locations.
- On Page 12, the following sentence "The piping associated with the Beach tanks which connect
 them to the fuel tanks owned by the North Warning System (NWS) though is not double walled,
 and as such has stricter regulations regarding the annual inspection." is no longer valid. The
 NWS separated the two fuel systems in 2010/2011; piping has been disconnected and capped
 off.
- In Appendix C of the Spill Contingency and Emergency Response Plan, the reference to "Biogenie" should be changed to "contractor".
