Dear Dele Morakinyo:

On February 5, 2007 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received Indian and Northern Affairs Canada's (INAC) site remediation for Roberts Bay and Ida Bay project proposal from INAC Lands Department. NIRB has assigned this project proposal file number, 07CN007.

The site remediation activities include:

- Mobilization/demobilization of equipment, materials/wastes and personnel
- Enhancement of site access routes
- Installation of a temporary dock
- Camp set-up and operation
- Hazardous material removal, handling and transportation
- Temporary storage on-site for hazardous materials, equipment and fuels
- Demolition of buildings and structures
- Debris consolidation and disposal
- Excavation and relocation or removal of contaminated soil
- Capping waste rock and tailings
- Quarrying of gravel and overburden materials
- Landfill construction
- Site grading
